The papers of Casper P. Kenny were deposited with the Labor History Archives in 3-10-66 by Casper Kenny.

Casper P. Kenny was born in Tuscola County, Michigan in August, 1905. A member of Buick Local 599 in Flint, he was Plant Committee-man from 1937-40, 1942-43 and 1949-59. In 1941 he served as Vice President of the C.I.O. Council. During 1941-42 he was Recording Secretary of Local 599. He was a member of the Shop Committee in 1942-43. Mr. Kenny was elected to the State House of Representatives from 1944-46. He was a Field Representative for the Public Workers-C.I.O. (S.C.M.W.A.) from 1943-48.

The Casper P. Kenny Collection covers the period from 1944 to 1948.
