The papers of Ken Morris were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs by Mr. Morris and were opened for research in January of 1969. Additional papers were placed in the Archives by Mr. Morris in August of 1970 and were opened for research in October of 1985.

Ken Morris joined UAW Briggs Local 212 in 1937 and immediately became active in union affairs. A Line Steward in 1937, he also was Assistant Editor of the Local 212 newspaper from 1937 to 1941. In 1939 he took charge of the Flying Squadron and organized picket lines and strike duties. He served on the Education Committee from 1938 to 1940. After his army service Mr. Morris was elected Recording Secretary of Local 212.

In 1948 he was elected President of the local and was re-elected five times. In April of 1955 he was elected Director of Region 1B, a position he held until his retirement in 1983.

Mr. Morris' community service activities included membership on the Oakland County Mental Health Board, the Oakland University Board of Trustees, and Chairman of the Oakland County UAW-CAP Council. Other public service assignments included membership on the National Commission on Unemployment and Compensation and the Michigan Employment Security Commission.

The papers in Part 1 of the Ken Morris Collection consist primarily of notes on contract negotiations between the UAW and the Packard Motor Company in 1953 and the collective bargaining agreements between the UAW and the Chrysler Corporation from 1958 to 1959.
