The papers of Vincent J. Murray were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in August of 1975 by Mr. Murray and were open for research in September of 1985.

Vincent J. Murray served a term as president of Dodge Truck Unit, Local 889, UAW-CIO and was active in Republican politics, holding the post of State chairman, Michigan Federation of Republican Labor Committees, and president Eisenhower Labor Committee, Wayne County, Michigan.

This collection consists of a copy of an article by Murray criticizing Walter Reuther which was inserted into the Congressional Record in May 1958 by Michigan Congressman Elford Cederberg.
