The papers of Herbert Wissman were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in May of 1990 by Herbert Wissman and were opened for research in September of 1992.

Herbert Wissman was an employee of the Hudson Motor Company in Detroit, Michigan from 1952 to 1955. The papers of Mr. Wissman relate primarily to the relationship of the Hudson Motor Company and the Foreman's Association of America. They include reports and findings of the National War Labor Board and the National Labor Relations Board in re the Hudson Motor Company and the Foreman's Association of America, supervisor's agreements with the Hudson Motor Company and the Ford Motor Company plus several pamphlets relating to the unionization of management.
