The Sixteenth Annual Region 1-B Leadership Institute, July 19-24, 1970, was held at the UAW Family Education Center at Black Lake, 25 miles south of the straits of Mackinac in Michigan's Lower Peninsula. Present were 255 students representing 36 locals in Region 1-B, 31 spouses of students, 18 staff members plus 6 spouses, and 33 invited guests. Theme of the summer school emphasized a participating membership to mobilize collective action in the shops, offices and community. The topic was "You and Your Standard of Living: Bargaining and Balloting 1970."
