The UAW Women's Department developed out of the UAW Women's Bureau, a division of the union's War Policy Department in the 1940s. The Women's Department was formally established at the union's 15th Constitutional Convention in 1955. The Women's Department addressed the specific problems that women faced in the workplace: equal pay, ending discrimination in hiring, promotion and training of women, as well as equal seniority protection. Through conferences, legislation, education, women's auxiliaries and committees, the UAW Women's Department sought to improve working conditions for women.

The papers of the UAW Women's Department collection consist of correspondence, minutes and other meeting material, conference material, clippings, publications, and reports.
