The materials of the United Auto Workers Local 525 were deposited in the Archives of Labor History and Urban Affairs in 1962.

United Auto Workers Local 525 formerly serviced Studebaker-Packard of Canada. It was organized within the UAW-CIO in 1949 and became affiliated with the Ontario Federation of Labor, and Canadian Congress of Labor in 1959. Now an amalgamated union Local 525, includes workers at Allen Industries, John Inglis Company, Limited, and other miscellaneous industries. It is part of Canadian Region 7 and consists of over 2,000 members.

The majority of papers consists of minutes of meetings, including three bound record books. The correspondence is limited and deals with financial matters.
