The papers of <u>Labor Today</u> were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in February and August of 1975 by its Co-Editor, Mr. Jim Williams, and were opened for research in June of 1988.

<u>Labor Today</u> is an independent labor journal currently published quarterly by the National Center of Trade Union Action and Democracy in Chicago. It began publication as a monthly in Detroit in 1962, and succeeded in order the following: <u>Labor Herald</u>, <u>Labor Unity</u>, and <u>The March of Labor</u>.

The <u>Labor Today</u> collection is primarily composed of subject files used by the newspaper's staff in writing articles on a wide range of issues relevant to the labor movement in the early 1970s. Also included are papers related to Mr. William's work as a National Education Association organizer for the faculty of the Pennsylvania State College and University system, 1969-1972, and materials on the organizational activities of Trade Union Action and Democracy, 1970-1975.
