The papers of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in June of 1983 and were opened for research in February of 1984.

The papers consist of photocopies from the National Archives and Records Service (file no. 199/3975) of correspondence, memoranda, clippings, and teletype reports relating to the General Motors strike of July and August 1939. They focus primarily on the efforts of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, through the services of Commissioner James F. Dewey, to attain a settlement of the strike.

Files are arranged chronologically. Files of correspondence and memoranda are grouped first, followed by teletype reports and clippings.
