The Merrill-Palmer Institute: Photographs and Audio-Visual Materials reflect the main functions of the institute throughout its history as an independent entity and almost twenty years into its relationship with Wayne State University. The bulk of the materials center on the operation of the Early Childhood Center (formerly the Merrill-Palmer Nursery School), but also cover its programs and services, teaching and research missions, and the Institute's physical environment.

Series 1: Photographs, 1920s-1990s Contains paper prints (8x10, 4x5, 2x3, and contact sheets), film negatives, film slides, and glass lantern slides. Documents all aspects of operation.

Series 2: Scrapbooks, 1920s-1965 Documents primarily through photographs, the Merrill-Palmer Camp for Boys and Girls established in 1930. Also documents nursery school activities; teaching aspects of the Institute, including international students and faculty; community programs; and research (restrictions apply).

Series 3: Audiovisual recordings, 1946-1986 Audio recordings of various programs and conferences, including a talk given by Margaret Mead, radio advertising spots, and interviews and observations with

children (restrictions apply). Video recordings and films mainly document programs and services, such as outdoor camp life, field trips, and another talk given by Margaret Mead.

Series 4: Architectural Plans and Drawings, 1890-1968. Blue-line, sepia-line, and blueprints documenting site plans, floor plans, mechanicals, and interior pieces for additions, remodels, and new construction for Merrill-Palmer buildings. Includes the Freer House, Palmer Building, dormitories, as well as some other Detroit area commercial and residential architecture.

Series 5: Memorabilia, 1920s - 1960s [RESTRICTED] Contains important objects related to Merrill-Palmer Institute's founding, building operations, teaching, and research.
