Abstract:	The Neighborhood Project was established by the Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Detroit in 1986. Its purpose was to retain a Jewish presence in the communities of Oak Park and Southfield, which were threatened by the construction of Interstate 696 and by demographic shifts. Interest-free loans were granted, and a revolving fund was established to assist in home purchases and, later, to provide home improvement loans. The project was completed in 2003 when it was deemed that the neighborhoods were stabilized and property values had increased. The Hebrew Free Loan Association continued to oversee the remaining loan program. The Neighborhood Project Records chronicle the development of the organization and its effect on the neighborhoods.
