Abstract:	JARC, formerly the Jewish Association for Retarded Citizens, was incorporated in 1969 as the Parents Association for Jewish Residential Care. The papers reflect the activities of JARC, a non-sectarian, non-profit agency, which provides residential, vocational and recreational services for developmentally disabled children and adults in Oakland County, Michigan. Advocacy and family assistance programs are also part of JARC's mission.

History

This non-sectarian, non-profit organization was incorporated in 1969 by a group of parents of developmentally disabled children and young adults. The group was known as the Parents Association for Jewish Residential Care (PAJRC). It met at the Jewish Community Center of Metropolitan Detroit and shared concerns about the future of these children. The group advocated for residential, vocational and recreational services for their children as well as those people who were being released into the

community from state institutions. Its goals included heightened community awareness and acceptance of the disabled.

Services developed slowly. In 1972, the first group home serving Jewish developmentally disabled adults opened in Detroit. In 1975 the group's name changed to the Association for Jewish Retarded and later to Jewish Association for Retarded Citizens. In 1977, a landmark state decision prohibiting local governments from using zoning laws to exclude group and foster homes allowed the work of this group to flourish. In 1980, the group took the official name of JARC, since the language of the previous names was "no longer considered dignified or accurate to describe the people served." (jarc.org)

Over the years, a constellation of services developed to serve people with a range of disabilities and their families. Programs include semi-independent apartment living, coordinated intervention services for dually diagnosed, and family assistance programs. By 1997, seventeen group homes existed throughout Oakland County. Annual fundraising programs augment state- federal (Medicaid) income to provide a high level of service to program participants.
