History

Jewish Family Service of Metropolitan Detroit (JFS) is a social service organization for the Detroit area's Jewish community. It was created in 1928 from the joining of the Hebrew Ladies Sewing Circle and the Self Help Circle, two early women's social service agencies. In its early years, JFS's specific mission was "finding homes for orphan children and supplying homemakers for families with an ill or absent mother." Its services expanded to aiding Jewish immigrant families and, in the aftermath of WWII, it worked toward resettlement of Holocaust survivors. Beginning in the 1970s, JFS served Jewish refugees leaving the Soviet Union. Today, it is a comprehensive social service provider, helping individuals of all ages and families within the Jewish and broader communities.

Scope and Content

The Jewish Family Service Records are made up of a variety of materials, divided into six series, documenting the many projects, programs and internal operations of the Jewish Family Service of Metropolitan Detroit (JFS). The first two series, Photographic Material and Major Services and Programs, reflect the organization's special events and campaigns. The Committees and Manuals series, along with the Inter-Agency Material series, provide a window into the internal operations and day-to-day work of the JFS through correspondence, staff training booklets, and meeting records. Scrapbooks containing newspaper clippings and photographs highlight notable accomplishments and prominent members of JFS. Finally, the Architectural Records series contains oversized blueprints and drawings of several facilities constructed to expand the operations of JFS.

Series 1: Photographic materials, 1950s-1990s

Contains photographs and negatives relating to agency celebrations, employees and meetings. Major groups of photos are related to the Resettlement Service, annual meetings, Group Apartments and JFS buildings. Some files contain general stock photographs along with various undocumented photographs. Other photos appear in the photo albums in Series 5.

Series 2: Major services and programs, 1930s-1990s

Contains documents and correspondence of the Resettlement Service includes reports, minutes and publicity. Other documents involve JFS buildings and properties, the children's department, the aged, Jewish House of Shelter, Sheruth House and other facilities. Papers include correspondence, reports and minutes.

Series 3: Committees and manuals, 1943-1995

Contains JFS material on various committee and groups as well as procedural handbooks, staff training, and child placement. Also included are reports and studies on JFS regarding reaccreditation and self-evaluation.

Series 4: Inter-Agency material, 1925-2008

Contains a number of different topics, including annual meeting speeches, programs, agency newsletters, and awards. Material related to the agency's activities, such as Homemaker, psychiatric care and counseling, is included. Information on urban crisis, housing relocation, the union and JFS's 50th anniversary is included within this series.

Series 5: Scrapbooks and photo albums, 1930-2000

Contains newspaper articles relating to JFS and its services. The articles have been copied on acid-free paper to preserve the information. All original articles have been destroyed. Photo albums and oversize boxes contain photographs, proof sheets, slides and negatives from a wide range of agency events.

Series 6: Architectural Records, 1959-1977

Contains large architectural documents such as blueprints and schematics of buildings at Greenfield Road and other locations.

Arrangement

This collection is arranged into 6 series: Series 1 (Boxes 1-3), Series 2 (Boxes 4-9), Series 3 (Boxes 10-13), Series 4 (Boxes 14-22), Series 5 (Boxes 23-25), Series 6 (Boxes 26-28).

Folders in each series are listed by their location within each box. They are not arranged, so any given subject may be dispersed throughout the records.
