The papers of E. Ray Skinner were donated to Wayne State University Archives by Mrs. E. Ray Skinner in August, 1967 and were open to researchers in September, 1969. Additional material was donated by Mrs. Skinner in January, 1974.

E. Ray Skinner, professor of Speech, became a member of the faculty of the College of the City of Detroit, forerunner of Wayne State University, in September, 1928. Born in Perkins, Oklahoma, he earned a B.S. degree at Oklahoma State University in 1919 and a Ph.D. in Speech at the University of Wisconsin in 1935. At the College of the City of Detroit he taught interpretive reading, voice and diction for thirty-eight years before retiring in 1966. During this time, Skinner was a popular campus figure and was instrumental in forming a men's faculty club, the Wayne University Club, and in developing various extra curricular activities within the Speech Department. He died in September, 1966.

The papers of E. Ray Skinner reflect his activities in the organization of the Wayne University Club, and various programs in interpretive reading and speech at Wayne State University.
