

The papers of Dr. Alexander J. Walt were placed in the Wayne State University Archive in April of 1996 by Mrs. Irene Walt.

Dr. Walt received his medical degree from the University of Cape Town in 1948, and completed his residency training at The Royal College of Surgeons in London and the Mayo Clinic in

Rochester, Minnesota. He served as chief of surgery at Detroit Receiving Hospital and Harper Hospital from 1965 to 1988. Dr. Walt was chairman of the Surgery Department at Wayne State University School of Medicine from 1966 to 1988, and he served as assistant and associate dean from 1965 to 1970. Following a sabbatical at Oxford University, Dr. Walt returned to Detroit to establish the comprehensive breast center which now bears his name. He was named distinguished professor of surgery at Wayne State University in 1990. In 1994, Dr. Walt was elected 75th president of the American College of Surgeons. He was the second Michiganian and the first foreign medical graduate ever to receive this honor. Dr. Walt died in 1996.

The papers of Dr. Walt primarily reflect his work with the Wayne State University School of Medicine.
