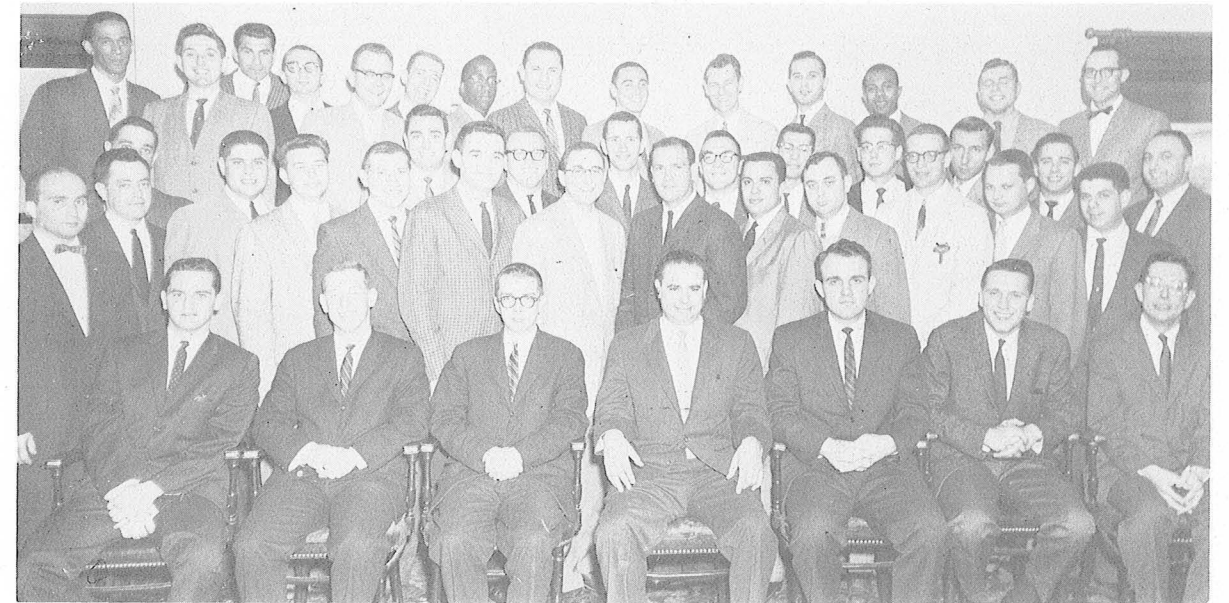

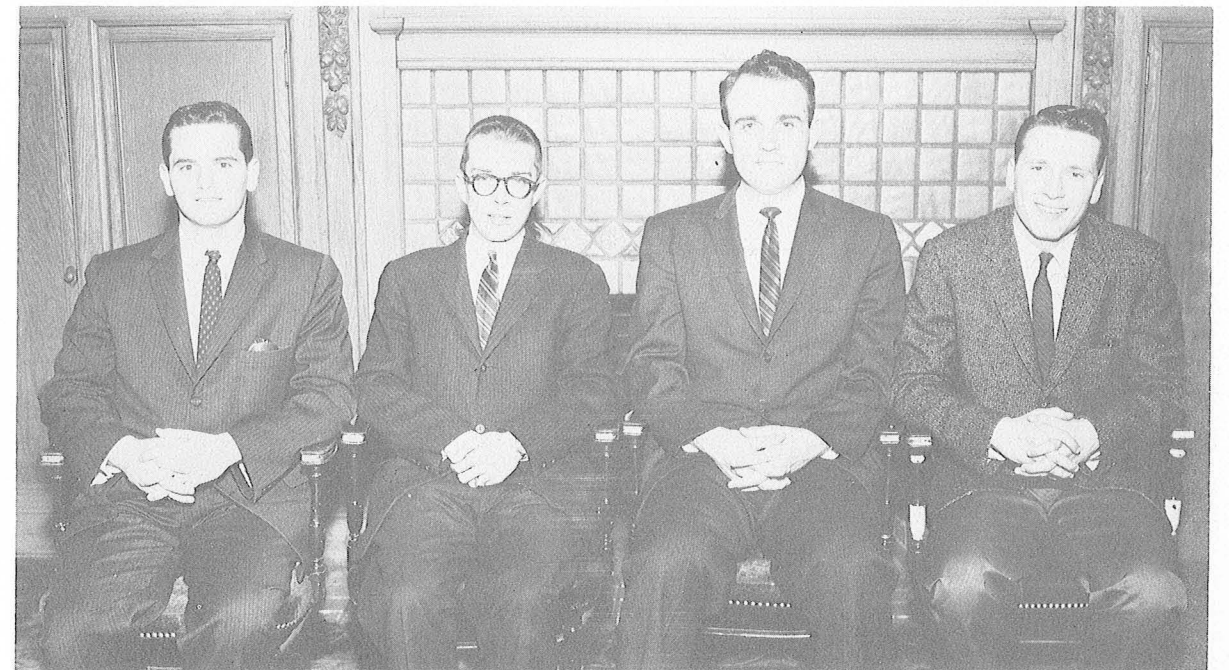

# School Celebrates Annual Law Day

The Law School observed its annual Law Day on Monday, May 12, 1958. It was a day filled with interesting and enjoyable programs. In the morning the students and faculty were treated to a stimulating panel discussion on "The Warren Court and Civil Liberties." Featured on the panel were Professor Francis A. Allen of the University of Chicago Law School, Associate Professor Charles W. Quick of Howard University Law School, and as moderator, Associate Dean John E. Glavin of Wayne State Law School. Dean Arthur Neef greeted the large assembly in the Kresge Auditorium and introduced the panelists. Following the discussion, Professors Allen and Quick were guests of the faculty at a luncheon in the Faculty Club.

At 3 p.m. the Student Board of Governors held an informal coffee hour and reception in honor of Professors Allen and Quick, at which time the students met the guests and conversed with them about the morning's panel topic.

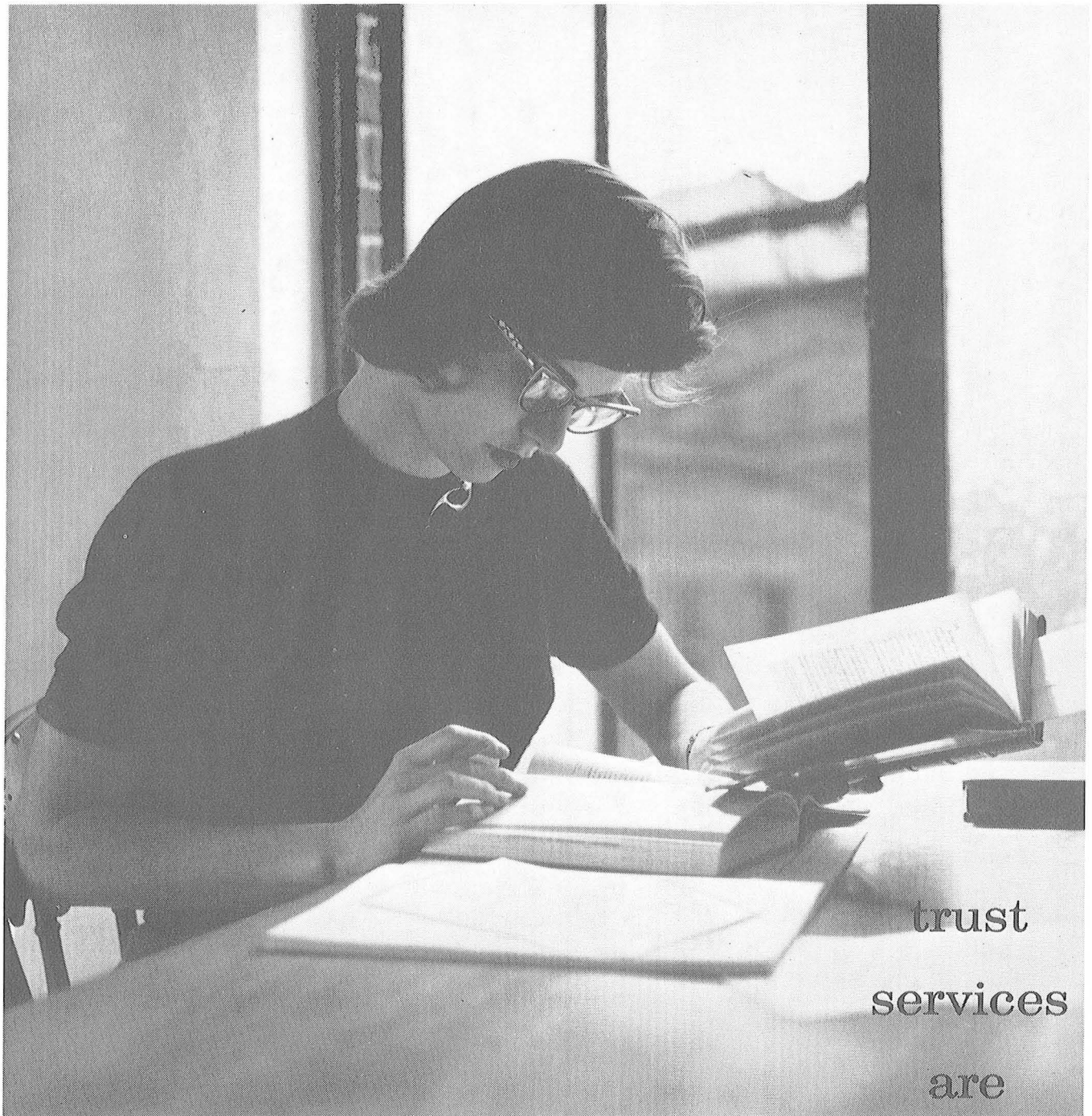
