

Margery A. Long Scholarship for Archival Administration

This scholarship fund is established to recognize scholastic achievement and to encourage continued academic progress. This grant will provide assistance to students in financing their education in the field of Archival Administration at Wayne State University.

Provisions:

The Margery A. Long Scholarship for Archival Administration is an award given annually to one student in Wayne State University's Archival Administration program. It is to be used toward tuition and other educational expenses.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Applicants must be full-time or part-time graduate students in the Wayne State University Archival Administration program.
2. A minimum GPA is not required.
3. Applicants need not demonstrate financial need.
4. Recipients may retain this award provided they continue to meet all criteria in the scholarship agreement, but renewal of this award is not automatic. Recipients must reapply and be reevaluated in order to retain this award.
5. A committee of Walter P. Reuther Library archivists will select the recipients of the award in accordance with university policies and procedures.
6. Awards will be distributed by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid in accordance with regular university policies and procedures.

How to Apply:

Applicants must write a 250-word essay on why they want to study the archival profession.

Applicants must submit the essay and a completed application with the names of three references and their contact information by the deadline of **August 1, 2008**. The award will be announced in August 2008. The funds will be available in September 2008.
