The papers of Robert Halbeisen were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in August 1963 by Mr. Halbeisen and were opened for research in February 1974.

In 1937 Robert Halbeisen served as a representative of the Textile Workers Organizing Committee during the Horner Brothers Woolen Mills strike in Eaton Rapids, Michigan. From 1946 through 1948 he was vice-president of United Public Workers Local 191, and in 1952 he became president of Local 52, Government and Civic Employees Organizing Committee, a CIO affiliate.

In addition, in the 1940's and 1950's, Halbeisen was involved with United Public Workers factional disputes, the Schoolcraft Gardens Cooperative Housing Project, reorganization of Michigan state government, Michigan Civil Service Commission collective bargaining, and welfare reform.
