The second and last installment of the Ivan Brown Collection was received by the Archives of Labor History and Urban Affairs on February 2, 1970. The processing of the collection was completed during March 1979.

Ivan Brown was born in Ishpeming on July 9, 1907. In 1932, he moved to Iron Mountain, and graduated from high school there in 1925. He attended Lawrence University for one year, after which he joined the J.C. Penney Company and was in their employe for twelve years, the last three of which he worked in their Traverse City branch.

In 1939 he joined the Ford Motor Company in Iron Mountain and became involved in the labor movement, helping organize the company in 1941.

The war began, the plant closed, and Ivan Brown went to Detroit and worked for a year at Continental Motors. When the Ford Motor Company started on war production, he was recalled to their Iron Mountain plant and worked there until 1950. That year he ran for a seat in the 12th congressional district, but lost in the election.

On October 1, 1950 he went on staff of the UAW Region 1-D, servicing the entire part of Northern Michigan. Prior to this new position, -he served as president of Local 952 - Ford. Motor Company - for almost nine years. He remained as International Representative of Region 1-D until he retired in 1969.

The papers in this collection reflect Mr. Brown's involvement with Local 952 in Iron Mountain and his role as International Represen—tative in Region 1-D.
