Abstract:	These papers reflect the various workings of Robert Tuxbury. They consist of correspondence, circular letters, meeting minutes, notes and research papers related to ALPA's bargaining activities, air safety and air traffic control. Some of the important correspondents include Harry Abrahams, David Behncke, and Clarence Sayen.

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History

Tuxbury was active in the Air Line Pilots Association since 1948, during a period that saw the reorganization of the union. As a pilot of United Air Lines, with his base in the New York - La Guardia airport, he participated in the local Air Safety Committee. In 1951 he became Chairman of the Master Executive Committee for U.A.L. pilots affiliated to A.L.P.A. Through this early period of Tuxbury's work, the union's main effort was devoted to the problem of safety and noise abatement in high density air traffic areas; the investigation of air crashes and the installment of radar procedures for take-off and landing were also related to the concern in flight safety. Various committees were created to cope with these matters, in which Tuxbury took part and of which he kept records, notes and research papers. In 1953, while continuing his activity in some of the committees formed during the previous years, Tuxbury was appointed as a member of A.L.P.A.'s negotiating committee in charge of the bargaining with U.A.L.

for the renewal of air pilot's contract. The materials that were provided both by the company and the union as a day-by-day basis for the discussion constitute a significant file in the collection, allowing researchers to follow the successive steps of bargaining activities. From 1956 to 1960 Tuxbury served as general Secretary of A.L.P.A.: his records for this period are far less specific than for the previous one, due to the new dimensions of his work. However, among the disputes in which A.L.P.A. became involved, two are documented in some detail in the collection: the troubled cooperation between the Air Traffic Committee and governmental agencies such as the Civil Aeronautics Board and the Federal Aviation Agency; and the conflict over flight engineers' union affiliation, which opposed A.L.P.A. to the Flight Engineers International Association and involved, at the peak of the dispute, other unions such as the International Association of Machinists, the Teamsters' Union and the A.F.L.-C.I.O. itself. After 1960 Tuxbury, no longer Secretary of the union, was still active in most of the bargaining between A.L.P.A. and air line companies. The merger between Capital and United Air Lines, which raised a six-year-long negotiation about the seniority to be awarded to pilots of either company; the likewise long-lasting dispute on the size and qualification of jet plane crew; and the general bargaining of 1966-68 are all documented in Tuxbury's notes, materials and research papers. After 1968 the collection is virtually extinguished, nor after 1970 is there any trace of further links between Tuxbury and the union's activity. He died in November, 1974.

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Scope and Content

The papers of Robert Tuxbury are basically constituted by correspondence, circular letters, minutes of meetings, notes and research papers related to A.L.P.A.'s bargaining activities, safety and traffic control committees and internal organization. This part of the collection may be considered a significant complement to the union's official papers, which also are deposited in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs. A far less extensive series of papers comprises manuals, bulletins and communications in general which were provided by U.A.L. to flight officers.

Part 1: Series 1: A.L.P.A. Committees and Negotiations, 1947-70. This series contains correspondence, circular letters, materials and notes, minutes of meetings, resolutions and statistical surveys, text of agreements between the union and several air line companies.

Series 2: A.L.P.A. Internal Organization, 1950-1968. Membership reports, materials and notes for A.L.P.A. Conventions in the 1950s, minutes of meetings, resolutions, union bulletins and newsletters are filed under this series.

Series 3: Pilot Materials, 1949-70. It contains research papers, flight instructions, handbooks, pilot training programs, bulletins, seniority and qualification lists provided by United Air Lines to Tuxbury as a flight officer.

Series 4: Personal Papers, 1951-1970. Miscellaneous notes unrelated to the subject of previous series, clippings and magazine copies originally filed with the clippings, and a script for a documentary movie have been placed in this series.

Part 2: Series 5: ALPA Committees and Negotiations, 1952 to 1969. Correspondence, records and other material relating to various ALPA councils, committees, and boards, and the issues with which they dealt. Particularly well documented is the Organizational Structure Study Committee, 1956-1964.

Series 6: ALPA Internal Organization and Operation, 1949-1965. Correspondence, minutes, guides and other material concerning ALPA's internal organization and operation. The union's Board of Directors and Executive Council are especially well represented.

Series 7: Air Line Employees Materials, 1936-1969. Technical manuals, newsletters, pamphlets and other material to which air line employees generally had access.

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Arrangement

Part 1: Arranged in four series – Series 1 (Boxes 1-12), Series 2 (Boxes 13-14), Series 3 (Boxes 14-15) and Series 4 (Box 15). Folders are arranged chronologically,

Part 2: Arranged in three series – Series 5 (Boxes 16-21), Series 6 (Boxes 21-24), and Series 7 (Boxes 24-28). Folders are arranged alphabetically, and then chronologically.

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Acquisition

The papers of Robert L. Tuxbury were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in two installments. The first was received in June of 1975 and the second in February of 1977; both were donated by Mrs. Tuxbury after her husband's death. The two sections were integrated and opened to research in April, 1979. Additional papers were placed in the Archives in November of 1983 and in November of 1984, and opened for research in June of 1988.

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Scope and Contents

This series is opened by the files of Master Executive Committee Chairman's correspondence for the years 1947-50, which Tuxbury inherited when appointed to the same office in 1951 (Boxes 1-2). The correspondence related to the New York Air Safety Committee's activities for 1950 was originally intermingled with those files and has been kept in that order. The remaining part of box 2 contains the general correspondence (not related to any of the particular subjects dealt with further in the collection) up to 1969. Boxes 3-12 contain papers dealing with specific committees; the original sequence of files has been maintained whenever possible. Per each broad field of activity, files proceed logically from the more general to the more specific content; chronological order has been followed in filing the succession of broader subjects. To facilitate the retrieval of subjects, an alphabetic list of the principal matters dealt with in the collection, with reference to their placement, is located at the end of the guide.
