The papers of Ronald Cohen were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in November of 1974 by Mr. Cohen and were open for research in July of 1986.

The papers of Ronald Cohen stem from his work in studying the Gary, Indiana schools from 1906-1940. More specifically his interests included the role of the Gary Teachers Union in the foundation of the American Federation of Teachers during the same period.

Ronald Cohen collected material relating to Gary's Teachers Union, local 4, and thus acquired this collection of United Labor News from William Wirt, the superintendent of schools in Gary from 1906-1938, and United Labor News editor D. W. Harter's son-in-law.
