The papers of Joseph R. Conlin were placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in August of 1975 by Mr. Conlin and were opened for research in April, 1982.

Joseph Conlin, Professor of History, California State University - Chico, (c. 1968) is the author of several books on the I.W.W., including a biography of William Haywood.
