Abstract:	Polly Howe worked for much of her career as a teach in Livonia and Dearborn Public Schools. She was an active member of the American Federation of Teachers and served on their Women's Rights Committee from 1987-1991. Howe was also a founding member of the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW) and helped found the Metro-Detroit Chapter. CLUW helped found the Michigan Pay Equity Network (PEN) in 1985 to study pay inequities among state employees. The organization has worked for over 30 years to try and eliminate sex and race based wage discrimination. An active participant of PEN, Howe served as a State Coordinator and aided in organizing the founding conference. Over her years of involvement with PEN, Howe organized a number of other conferences and rallies throughout the state. She also served as Chair of PEN in 2005. This collection primarily contains material related to pay equity, though there is a small amount of information on the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW) 10th anniversary. Biography

Polly Howe received a bachelors of arts from Michigan State University in 1946. After graduating, Howe continued her education, obtaining a Masters in Education from Wayne State University in 1952 and a Ph.D in Sociology from Wayne State University in 1972.

Howe worked as a teacher in Livonia and Dearborn Public Schools, as well as at Henry Ford Community College. Howe was an active member of the American Federation of Teachers (AFT) from 1948-1989 and served as a delegate to several conventions. She also served on the Women's Rights Committee of AFT from 1987-1991.

Outside of teaching Howe became involved in women focused organizations like the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW). Howe was a founding member of CLUW and also helped found the Metro-Detroit Chapter. CLUW helped create the Michigan Pay Equity Network (PEN) in 1985 with the purpose of studying pay inequities among state employees. The organization has worked for over 30 years to try and eliminate sex and race based wage discrimination. An active participant of PEN, Howe served as a State Coordinator and aided in organizing the founding conference. Over her years of involvement with PEN, Howe organized a number of other conferences and rallies throughout the state. She also served as Chair of PEN in 2005.

In 2005, Polly Howe was named an education foundation honoree by the American Association of University Women (AAUW) and in 2007 she was named Feminist of the Year by the Detroit National Organization for Women in 2007.
