## **Abstract**

The Michigan Federation of Teachers (MFT) was founded in 1935 at a meeting in Ann Arbor with representatives from ten Michigan local that were all affiliated with the American Federation of Teachers. They formed a state federation to address immediately the issue of tenure for teachers in the state of Michigan. The MFT struggled to remain viable in the state over the years and when collective bargaining was allowed for public employees the MFT had to quickly find the resources and staff to organize the tens of thousands of schoolteachers. The MFT struggled to win collective bargaining elections and although gained in presence in some school districts its membership only reached 15,000 by 1970. The MFT lobbied the state legislator over state aid, especially ensuring state money went to public schools rather than public schools and teacher retirement issues. The MFT began organizing in other areas such as with paraprofessionals and higher education; nevertheless, by 1980 the MFT only increased its membership by 1,000 members and faced constant raids by the Michigan Education Association. The MFT did however begin to organize and grow in membership over the next decade become a real force in the state of Michigan.

Part III covers the period from the late 1930s through the 1970s. The collection's bulk documents the efforts to organize teachers during the 1960s and 1970s and dealing with the strikes that accompany labor disputes which is represented in the series Locals. There is ample amount of information about the American Federation of Teachers growth and inner workings during the 1960s and 1970s in the convention files; within these files there are not only basic convention materials but also notes from committee work and flyers from various factions within the AFT. MFT was a part of policy in education finances, assessments of teachers and teacher centers and is reflected in files dealing with the department of education and the like. Teacher placement files are a unique look in how African-American teachers were affected with the integration of schools in the South. The collection covers a broad range of topics with specific details on education reform in the 1970s, collective bargaining issues for teachers, political structures in Michigan and various issues on civil rights in Michigan, particularly the bussing of students. Series five contains photographs and audio recordings.
