BLUEPRINT FOR ACTION

AS SUBMITTED BY THE STRATEGY COMMITTEE AND OVERWHELMINGL ADOPTED BY THE MINISTERS MEETING AT MASON TEMPLE, FEBRUARY 25

OUR OBJECTIVE: JUSTICE (for the Sanitation workers accordin their demands) and JOBS (many jobs for the poor and Negroes).

OURIMMEDIATE STRATEGY:

- 1. A boycott downtown and including all branches of bu downtown and the businesses owned by Councilmen.
- 2. No new clothes for Easter. Keep your money in your
- 3. Do not read, subscribe to or buy either of the two daily newspapers.
- 4. We want to try and mobilize the other 18,000 city employees.
- 5. Conduct nightly mass meetings beginning Monday at Clayborne Temple at 7:30 p. m.

EACH MINISTER IS ASKED TO GO BEFORE HIS PEOPLE AND URGE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Support the above 5 points.

2. Organize an action committee in each church.

3. Take offerings for the campaign and collect food for the workers.

4. Form a telephone committee to call each member of the church about the five points above.

5. Have each member to call at least five other people in

support of this effort.

6. Ministers and members are asked to move through their neighborhoods encouraging people to join the boycott of downtown stores and their branches and all businesses named Loeb.

7. The ministers plan to march together.

8. Support the demonstrations which begin Monday, February 26 meeting at 9:30 a.m. at Clayborne Temple.

9. Ministers must preach and teach soul-force.

- 10. People canceling their newspapers should if possible pay their carriers' wages.
- 11. Ministers can call white ministers they know and try to set them straignt.
- 12. On a designated Sunday churches will be asked to leave their worship at a certain hour, march together downtown for a prayer meeting together.

13. When you cancel the newspapers also call the paper or write telling them why.
