Abstract

The American Federation of Teachers is a labor union representing primary and secondary school teachers, paraprofessionals, higher education faculty and professional staff, and nurses and other health care professionals. The AFT Educational Issues Department, originally the Task Force on Educational Issues, is the research and development arm of the union. The department tracks education policies from local, state and national bodies, conducts research and analysis on those policies, produces briefs and reports, conducts workshops, and assists local AFT affiliates on educational issues. A major initiative of the department is the Education Research & Dissemination program (ER&D). The program began in 1981 with a grant from the National Institute of Education. It is focused on professional development through the collection of a body of research on education issues and translation of that material to classroom applications. Teachers are able to access research and apply new techniques in their classrooms. The ER&D program explores topics such as instruction methods, critical thinking, behavior management, and student motivation. Projects include the Visiting Practitioner program and Thinking Mathematics. The Educational Issues Department also organizes the bi-annual QuEST (Quality Educational Standards in Teaching) Conference.

The AFT Education Issues Department Records contain correspondence and chronological files, meeting minutes, reports, manuscripts and drafts, annotated articles, reports, conference packets, press releases, newsletters, fliers, photographs, negatives, and VHS and audiocassette tapes. The records contain communications with and publications from many education-related organizations as well as granting institutions.

Arrangement

Series 1: Chronological Files, 1979-2003 (Boxes 1-27, 131-133, 137-140)

Chronological files, much of which is correspondence, are from various staff members of the AFT and Educational Issues Department. Includes material from Albert Shanker, Sandra Feldman, Eugenia Kemble, Ruth Wattenberg, Burnie Bond, Dale Boatright, Carolyn Trice, Marsha Berger, Dawn Krusemark, Lovely Billups, Marilyn Rauth, and many others. Some runs of files are from various departments or pertain to specific subjects, such as the President's office, international affairs, and human rights.

Series 2: Educational Research & Dissemination, 1979-2000 (Boxes 27-40, 140-141)

Materials include reports, speech transcripts and notes, meeting minutes, press kits, budget records, directories, training manuals, newsletters including *ER&D Update*, published and annotated articles, and related correspondence. Subjects include local leaders conferences, student and teacher dropouts, parent involvement, school safety, critical thinking, race and multicultural issues. ER&D is a major and ongoing initiative and related materials may appear in other series.

Series 3: Subject Files, 1934, 1947-2002 (Boxes 38, 40-126, 133-135, 142-157)

Major subjects represented include special education and inclusion, dropouts, the National Education Association, conventions and conferences, bilingual education, education-related legislation and policies, reform and restructuring, teacher certification and professional development, class size, charter schools, civil rights, parent involvement, the K-12 Program and Policy Council, paraprofessionals, and internal departmental matters. Many of these records came from the central files of the Educational Issues Department. Also included are major project administration files and collaborations with many education-related organizations.
