# History

Stephen Lighthill has been involved in a large number of film productions, including social documentaries, feature films, and television. He has worked as a camera operator, cinematographer, and director. He is currently (August 2010) a Senior Filmmaker-in-Residence at the American Film Institute Conservatory. In 1979, he produced and directed a documentary film in Detroit called *Taking Back Detroit*. The film features a movement that took an alternative approach to addressing Detroit's long-term economic difficulties. The primary subjects are Kenneth V. Cockrel, Justin C. "Chuck" Ravitz, Sheila Murphy (Cockrel), and the Detroit Alliance for a Rational Economy (D.A.R.E.). Mr. Cockrel an attorney and socialist, was elected to the Detroit city council in 1977. Mr. Ravitz, also a socialist, was a criminal defense attorney from 1966 to 1973, and participated in several of Detroit's most celebrated trials of the time. He was elected as a judge on the Detroit Recorder's Court in 1973, where he served until 1986 and where he presided over several major cases. He then went back into private practice in civil litigation and ultimately mediation services. Mr. Ravitz passed away in 2007. Sheila Murphy (Cockrel), a labor, educational and community activist was campaign manager for both Ravitz & Cockrel.

The film highlights the problems facing Detroit and gives a short overview of some of the events that created those problems. Mr. Cockrel, Mr. Ravitz, Ms. Murphy and D.A.R.E. members are shown at work in their offices, in the city council chamber, in the courtroom, and on the streets of Detroit. They are depicted promoting their program and developing strategies in their efforts to persuade the City of Detroit to emphasize providing services to residents and maintaining and developing neighborhoods over tax abatements and federal grants to large corporations for blockbuster developments. Included are interviews with Mr. Cockrel, Mr. Ravitz, and Ms. Murphy as well as with several individuals discussing Detroit's problems and Mr. Ravitz.

## **Scope and Content:**

This collection includes the raw sound and film footage used to create the documentary *Taking Back Detroit* as well as intermediate materials in the film making process. Box 24 contains three final prints of the complete film. The sound and film footage records Detroit in 1979, including the crumbling industrial, business, and residential infrastructure. As well as the matters noted above, the sound and film footage also records Detroit city council meetings, community meetings, D.A.R.E. meetings, petition drives, and D.A.R.E.'s "City Life in the '80s" conference.

## Series I: Sound Recordings and Videocassette, 1979-1980

Sound recordings on 1/4 inch mono reel-to-reel tape for the documentary "Taking Back Detroit," including both sound recorded while synchronized with the film footage being shot and also "wild sound," sound recordings made while the cameras were not rolling. The first box also contains a VHS videocassette of the finished, 58 minute documentary as broadcast on public television.

# Series II: 16mm Film Negatives and Interpositives, 1979-1980

16mm film negatives for the documentary "Taking Back Detroit," stored in lengths of no more than 400' contained in metal film canisters.

## Series III: 16mm Film Prints, circa 1980

16mm positive film sound and picture work prints for the documentary "Taking Back Detroit," stored in rolls of film of varying lengths and shorter segments. The storage boxes contain several smaller boxes each of which usually contains two larger rolls of film or several smaller rolls of film. Some boxes also contain segments of film rolled but not on spools. The last three boxes of this series were added later. Box 24 contains three copies of the finished film.

## Arrangement

The Stephen Lighthill Film Collection is arranged into three series: Series I (Boxes 1-3), Series II (Boxes 4-7), and Series III (Boxes 8-24). Series I is first divided by the length of the reel to reel sound tapes with 1200' tapes separate from 600' tapes for ease of storage. Each film size is further arranged by the number assigned to each roll of tape by the film crew, with unnumbered tapes included at the end in chronological order. Series II is arranged numerically by film roll number, followed by unnumbered film rolls in alphabetical order, and finally unnumbered and unlabelled film rolls by canister number. Series III is in the original order as received from the donor.
