The papers of William R. Copeland were deposited with the Archives of Labor History and Urban Affairs in 1968 and 1972 by William Copeland.

Mr. Copeland was first elected to the Michigan State House of Representatives in 1952. He is currently the ranking Democrat on the Approviations Committee, the Capital Outlay Committee and the Administrative Rules Committee. He is chairman of the Air Pollution Committee and a member of the Water Pollution Committee. In the 1969 session of the state legislature, Mr. Copeland was made Chairman of the Appropriations Committee.

Mr. Copeland was born on May 8, 1909 in Washington, Indiana. He is a high school graduate. By occupation he was a rigger. He is a former member of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors and the City Council of Wyandotte. He is a member of the St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, West Side Polish-American Citizens Club, South End Club, Pennsalt Club, a past president of the Eagles and a past president of the United Mine Workers Local 12100.

Additional material pertaining to Mr. Copeland has been placed with the Wyandotte Museum.
