The papers of Philip Rahoï were deposited with the Labor History Archives in April, 1968 by Philip Rahoï.

Philip Rahoï was born April 5, 1896, in Iron Mountain, Michigan, and was active in the political life of that area. He was elected to the Michigan House of Representatives in 1934 and 1936. He served in the Michigan Senate from 1954 to 1966 under the Democratic Party.

The Collection covers the period from 1934 to 1968.
