The papers of Jan B. Vanderploeg were deposited with the Labor History Archives in May 1968 by Jan Vanderploeg.

Jan B. Vanderploeg was born in Holland, Michigan in 1900. He graduated from Hope College in 1922, and he later attended Western Theological Seminary and Harvard University. He was employed by the National Park Service in Maryland from 1934-1936, and he worked as a land planner with the resettlement administration in Arkansas, Louisiana, and Mississippi from 1936-1938.

He then returned to Muskegon, Michigan where he established himself as a landscape architect. From 1957 until 1963, he was a member of the Board of Trustees of Michigan State and Oakland Universities. In 1964, he was elected to the Michigan Senate from the 33rd district of Muskegon. He served in the Senate until 1966. Most of the records in this collection relate to these three aspects of his career

The collection also contains some documents pertaining to his experiences as a North Muskegon Alderman, as a president of the Michigan Laymen's Fellowship of Congregational Churches, as a lay minister, as a member of the Governor's Commission on Employment of Older Workers, as chairman of the Muskegon County Democratic Committee, as secretary of the Ninth Congressional Democratic Committee, as a Democratic candidate for the State Senate and for United States Congress, as a Presidential Elector in 1960, as a substitute high school English teacher, as as chairman of the Committee on Regent Responsibility for University Participation in Education Aboard, a sub-committee of Governing Boards of State Universities and Colleges.
