In 1948, at the age of 29, Garland Lane was elected a Democratic State Senator from Genesee County, Michigan. During his years in the Senate and to the present time, Senator Lane has been an important member of the Appropriations Committee. From 1964-1967 Senator Lane was chairman of the committee.

The Garland Lane Collection covers the period from 1964 to 1967.
