The papers of Willoughby Abner were placed in the Archives of Labor History and Urban Affairs in April of 1972 by Mr. Abner and were opened for research in December of 1972.

Mr. Abner, a native of Chicago, was born Dec. 6, 1920. He spent a few years in Detroit as a child but spent most of his life in his native city. After graduating from Wilson Junior College Mr. Abner obtained a law degree from the John Marshall Law school in 1947 but chose not to take the bar examination.

Mr. Abner served as President of Amalgamated Local Union 734 in Chicago. He joined the staff of the International Union, UAW as an International Representative in September 1949, served as Citizenship and Education Director, Region 4 UAW and was President of the Chicago Area UAW Citizenship Council 1952-56. In March, 1963 Abner became Assistant Director for the UAW Labor Studies Center at Solidarity House in Detroit.

In addition to his work with the UAW Mr. Abner played an active role in the leadership of the Chicago NAACP.

At the time he placed his papers in the Archives Mr. Abner was National Director of the National Center for Dispute Settlement of the American Arbitration Association, Washington, D.C. He was serving in that post at the time of his death, Dec. 3, 1972.

The papers of Mr. Abner reflect his work with the UAW, and to a lesser extent, his involvement in civil rights and community activities.
