The Merrill-Palmer Institute Collection was placed in the Archives of Labor and Urban Affairs in January of 1982 and were opened for research in May of 1989. The Grams papers *are* part of the Merrill-Palmer Institute Administration Col lection.

Armin Grams was born in Chicago, Illinois on October 20, 1924. He received a B.S. in Education from Concordia Teachers College in 1945, a M.A. at DePaul University in 1947 and a Ph.D in Child Development at Northerstern University in 1952 and attended Northwestern Theological Seminary in 1958-59. He was a teacher and principal in elementary schools in Chicago, 1945-49; was Assistant Professor of Education and Psychology at DePaul University 1949-55; Associate Professor of Psychology at Wisconsin State College, LaCross 1955-57; Instructor in Child Development University of Minnesota 1957-62; Head of the Human Development Programat the Merrill-Palmer Institute 1962-71; Professor of Early Childhood & Human Development, University of Vermont 1971.

His professional interests were in developmental psychology, parent-child relations, and child rearing. He was a member of many professional societies and published many articles in journals. He was the author of a number of books in the parent-child field.

The papers of Armin Grams reflect his position at the Merrill-Palmer Institute where he supervised and colaborated with a number of staff members whose papers are included in his files: J. Chantiny, I. Echols, F. Gould and C.S. Rothschild.

Included in the Grams papers *are* the Paul Grams files. Paul was the son of Armin Grams. His papers indicate that he worked as editor of various Merrill-Palmer publications from 1975-77, and also worked as communications coordinator.
