The papers of Kurt Keydel were placed in the University Archives by Mr. Keydel in May, 1972.

Kurt Keydel was the son of Oscar Keydel, who brought a statue of Johann Gutenberg from Mainz, Germany in 1885. Mr. Keydel attempted to have the statue mounted on the campus of Michigan State University in 1946 and subsequently on the campus of Wayne State University in 1965.
