The Harold C. Mack, M.D., Collection was given to the University Archives in May, 1972 by Dr. Harold C. Mack.

Dr. Mack, professor of gynecology and obstetrics at the Wayne State University School of Medicine, received his medical degree in 1925 from the University of Michigan. Following his internship and residency at Harper Hospital under Dr. George Kamperman, Mack studied obstetrics and gynecology at the Frauenlinik associated with the University of Berlin. Dr. Mack returned to Detroit in 1929, established a private practice and continued the research he had begun in Europe in Harper Hospital.

During his long professional career in Detroit, Dr. Mack was a staff member at Hutzel, Herman Kiefer, Detroit General Hospital and Chief of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Harper Hospital, 1954-1963. Dr. Mack joined the faculty of the Wayne University School of Medicine in 1931 as a clinical assistant professor and became chairman of the Gynecology and Obstetrics Department in 1962.

Dr. Harold C. Mack retired from the University and was appointed Professor Emeritus in September, 1970.

In addition to his teaching and research, Dr. Mack served as president of the Michigan Society of Obstetricians and Gynecologists in 1934, president of the Central Association of Obstetricians and Gynecologists in 1940, president of the American Association of Obstetricians and Gynecologists in 1967-68, Chairman of the Michigan State Medical Society section on Obstetrics and Gynecology, and a member of the committee on the Study of Legal Aspects of Therapeutic Abortion, Sigma Xi, the Detroit Academy of Medicine, and a fellow of the American College of Surgeons. Dr. Mack was also a founding member of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology and has served on its executive board and as district chairman.

The papers of Harold C. Mack, M.D. primarily reflect the writings and achievements of Dr. Mack, as well as his involvement in the Detroit Medical Community.

One certificate - The American Association of Obstetricians, Gynecologists and Abdominal Surgeons Foundation, Inc. Annual Prize for 1942 - has been removed from the collection and placed with oversized material.
