Abstract: Ruth Ellsworth was a professor of Social Studies Education at Wayne

State University in the College of Education from 1949 to 1977. She served on several committees at Wayne State University such as Wayne State University Retirement Committee, the Wayne State University Council Public Relations Committee, the Wayne State University Calendar Committee, Wayne State University's Quarter System Committee, and Wayne State University's Committee on Teacher Education. This collection is comprised of the papers from

these committees and the work that she contributed.

Biographical / Historical

Ruth Ellsworth was born in 1908 and received her Bachelor of Arts from Western Michigan University, her Master of Arts from Columbia, and her Ph.D. in Philosophy from Northwestern University. She came to Wayne University in 1949 as an assistant professor and retired as a full professor in 1977. She was a professor of Social Studies Education in the College of Education and an important voice for children's welfare. Ellsworth was held in high esteem for her work with UNICEF over the years. Ellsworth was a member of several professional and civic groups, such as National Council for the Social Studies Board of Directors (1958 to 1960), Association for Student Teaching (1955 to 1957), Michigan Association for Student Teaching: President (1953 to 1955), National Education Association, Michigan Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development: Executive Board (1954 to 1957), and the Michigan Council for the Social Studies: Board of Directors (1965 to 1971). Ellsworth wrote several publications from 1948 to 1972 on elementary school education, social studies, and curriculum. Ruth Ellsworth passed away on July 14th, 2003 at age 94.
