History

Dr. Theodore D. Rice (1904-1989) was a Professor of Education at Wayne State University (WSU) for fifteen years, from 1957 to 1972. He received his Bachelor of Arts (1927) and Master of Arts (1932) degrees from the University of Denver, and his Ph.D. in Education from Northwestern University in 1943. Before coming to WSU, Dr. Rice worked as a teacher and principal at Yuma County High School from 1927 to 1929, and as a teacher, department head, and supervisor in the Denver Public Schools from 1930 to 1939. He served as an Associate Professor at Oklahoma A&M College from 1945 to 1947, and concurrently as the Assistant Superintendent in charge of curriculum for Oklahoma City Public Schools. Dr. Rice left Oklahoma for New York University (NYU), where he was a Professor for ten years (1947-1957) before coming to Wayne State. He specialized in secondary education. While at NYU, both Dr. Rice and his

wife Dr. Chandos Reid Rice, an Assistant Professor at Columbia University's Teachers College, received Fulbright scholarships to spend a year abroad (1953-1954) at the University of Madras in India. He also spent a sabbatical year as a Visiting Professor of Education in 1964 at the University of Hawaii, and as a Research Scholar at the New Delhi University in India (1964-1965). Dr. Rice was active in local civic organizations and served as the President of the United States (U.S.) Section of the World Education Fellowship, a voluntary and non-partisan UNESCO non-governmental organization. He and his wife spent their retirement years in Colorado, where he stayed active lobbying on behalf of senior citizens and elder issues. Dr, T.D. Rice passed away in Boulder, Colorado in 1989.
