History

The Center for Peace and Conflict Studies (CPCS) was created on November 20, 1965 and directed by Russell Broadhead. It was originally monikered as the Center for Teaching About War and Peace. In 1987, the Wayne State University Board of Governors changed the name to its current iteration. The center's founding mission focused on the means to develop and implement projects, programs, curricula, research and publications in areas of scholarship related to international and domestic peace, war, social injustice, arms control, globalization, multicultural awareness, and constructive conflict resolution. CPCS has developed over the past few decades as a provider in community outreach through programs that emphasize conflict resolution, development of intercultural understanding, and enhancement of local knowledge of global affairs.

Scope and Content

This collection contains 3 series: Departmental Files, Publications, and Oversize and Audiovisual. The Departmental Files contains materials pertaining to the history and the inner-workings of the Center for Peace and Conflict Studies (CPCS), including a number of meeting minutes, workshop programs, and event fliers. The Publications series published works dealing with topics of interest to CPCS, such as global education, international affairs, and military issues. The Oversize and Audiovisual series contains two oversize items, photographs, VHS tapes, cassettes, and photographic slides.
